On Thursday, January 25, 2018 our school will take part in a celebration of National School Choice Week. We will be participating in a Legislative Reception at the Rhode Island State House from 2-5pm to promote expanded school choice in education in Rhode Island.

Our event will be one of over 5,000 events being held during National School Choice Week! National School Choice Week spotlights the importance of effective educational options for children both across the nation and across here in Rhode Island. During the week, there will be celebrations of student achievement, parent involvement, excellent teachers and unique learning environments provided by both the public and private schools in Rhode Island.

As an elected official of the State of Rhode Island your awareness of expanded parental choice in education is very important to the citizens of our state. As you know, we have a tax credit scholarship program in Rhode Island which saves the state over \$5 million a year in education expenses. There is legislation in the House (House Bill 7055) to raise the cap on this program which will save the state millions of more dollars and give more families choices in the education of their children.

In addition to the Legislative Reception on January 25th the dome of the State Capitol will be illuminated in yellow to signify the citizens call for expanded school choice in Rhode Island.
